

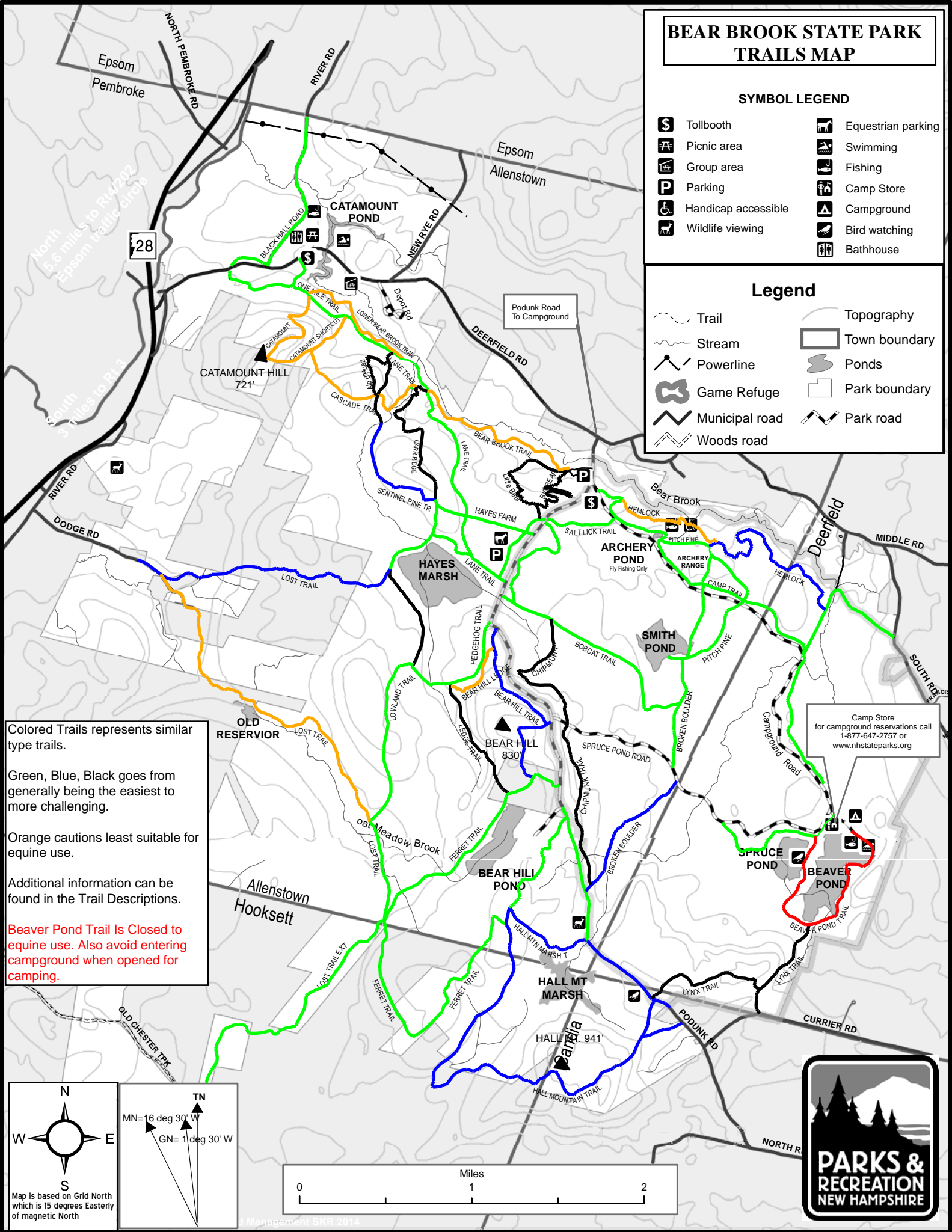
BEAR BROOK STATE PARK TRAILS MAP
